### **Pre-Bid Meeting (April 30, 2019) Minutes**

- BCRP has already submitted building permit plans. Those are expected to be approved well before NTP. Responsibility for permit fees are stipulated in the Bid Documents. I believe BCRP pays for the overall building permit, and that any individual permits, including fees (such as trade-required permits (demolition, sprinkler, etc.) are the responsibility of the contractor).
- 2. The project completion deadline is stipulated in the Contract Documents as 90 days from Notice to Proceed. Based on feedback today BCRP will consider modifications to this and if changes are made an Addendum will be issued immediately. (See immediate changes attached to Addendum #1, as well as Item #5 below.)
- 3. BCRP does not intend to provide an environmental report associated with this facility or this project. This is because the date of the building's original construction, the scope of the project, etc. would indicate very little, if any, hazardous materials involved. The Bid Documents are clear that all hazardous materials encountered as part of the construction project must be handled/disposed of in compliance with current codes and laws.
- 4. There will be a full-time city inspector assigned to this project during the construction period.
- 5. The facility will be closed to the public from 6/1/2019 through 8/31/2019. Staging, access, etc. are wide open to the awarded contractor during this period. Work after this date would need to coordinate access, temporary utilities, and life safety with partial operation of the facility. By September 13<sup>th</sup> all four locker rooms must be complete and functioning. By September 29<sup>th</sup> all interior work must be completed and the main (front) entry, via new handicapped ramp, must be accessible to the public.
- 6. May 9, Noon will be the Deadline for questions.
