

- 8. A pre-bid conference and site visit/tour will be held for all trades at **Montgomery College Takoma Park/Silver Spring Campus**. - 12. The successful Bidder(s) will be required to enter into an agreement with Barton Malow Company on the Agreement Form identified in Section 000500 of the Project Manual.
