#### ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the Fruitland Water System Upgrade - Supply Well and Water Treatment Plant will be received by the City of Fruitland (herein called the "OWNER") at the City Hall, 401 East Main Street, Fruitland, Maryland 21826, until **1:30 p.m., (EST) on October 25, 2019**. Said bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud immediately afterwards at the Council Chambers, 401 East Main Street, Fruitland, Maryland.

The Fruitland Supply Well and WTP Upgrade generally consists of, but is not limited to, the construction/installation of the following: new 600 gpm 12-inched cased water supply well, 4<sup>th</sup> Greensand Pressure Filter System, mechanical modifications to existing three (3) pressure filter units, new 43,000 gallon Reclaim Tank and recycle system, updated electrical controls, chemical feed systems and all associated appurtenances. The Contractor shall provide all labor, equipment, tools, appliances, materials and incidentals and shall perform all operations required to completely finish all of the work in the manner approved by the Engineer.

A Pre-Bid meeting will be held at **1:30 p.m., (EST) on October 10, 2019** at the City of Fruitland Council Chambers, 401 East Main Street, Fruitland, Maryland to allow Contractors an opportunity to obtain information on the project from the Engineer and the Owner. A SITE VISIT will be held immediately following the meeting.
