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6. Question: Is there a hazardous material report available?

Answer: Yes. Please reference the "Exhibits" folder distributed with the bid package. Exhibits 6 & 7 are HAZMAT surveys for Falcon Hall and Science South.

7. *Question: Will you distribute the bid list (attendance sheet)?*

Answer: Yes. See attached.

8. Question: Will you distribute a copy of the presentation?

Answer: Yes. See attached.

9. Question: Is crushing (of concrete) an option for this project?

Answer: All work is to be performed in accordance with the City of Takoma Park and/or Montgomery County's allowable noise levels. If the crushing of concrete on the project site remains under the allowable threshold, yes, it will be allowed. All work is to also comply with all regulatory air quality/dust requirements.
